**Conditions:**

1. This school has been registered in accordance with school recognition under the rules framed in Right of Education of children 2009 and Karnataka Education Act 1983, the recognition of the recognition renewed up to the standard renewed. Excluding these sections there is no provision to open additional classes and sections.
2. Shall perform under the rules framed under Right of Education of children 2009 and Karnataka Education Act 1983.
3. Under the Right to Education of children 2009 should reserve 25% seat for children of weaker sections. For the schools comes under the RTE limits, has power to admit the seats reserved under the

- RTE Act. (The Govt. has framed the rules as it will useful to the parents to admit their children in nearby schools, accordingly, if the Govt. Govt. recognized schools are existing, the children should be admitted to that school) if not existing, the Private schools should admit the children and provide education up to primary level. Should allow these students to continue their studies without any partiality.
4. As described in para 3, the fees for the children admitted under RTE the Govt. will release the fees. Therefore, prohibited to collect any fees from these students.
  5. The school and school management should not collect any capitation fees and should not collect the donations from the parents.
  6. The School/Management should publish the information of collecting of fees in their schools from the school from parents in the departmental website and school notice board under the State Govt. Notification No.ED 31/PGC/2019, dated: 27.07.2019.
  7. The school/management should admit the students as prescribed by the Govt.
  8. The school/management should not refuse the admission against these points.
    - (i) Due to lack of age proof
    - (ii) Based on the caste, religion, place of birth, language
    - (iii) If admission requested after expiry of the extended admission period.
  9. Should take all the safety measures as per the RTE Act and Rules, Karnataka Education Act and Rules (Fire Safety and building safety certificate from the concerned authorities and Children study safety as per the K.S.C.P.C.R and N.C.P.C.R.)
  10. The school/management should
    - (i) Should not withhold or terminate from the college till completion of Primary Education and Middle School education from the school.
    - (ii) No child shall be subjected to physical or mental abuse.
    - (iii) Any child is not required to pass any board exams till completion of the primary education.
    - (iv) For every child who completes the Primary education will be given the certificate as prescribed in RTE Rule 21 and Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
    - (v) As per the rules and regulations of the RTE Act and Karnataka Education Act and rules, the school should admit the specially challenged children
    - (vi) The appointed teachers should consists of the minimum qualification prescribed for the Primary and Secondary School teachers in RTE Act and Rules and Karnataka Education Act and Rules and Govt. orders.
    - (vii) The salary and other allowances payable to the teachers and as per the Service Rules and conditions and the salary will be paid to the teachers through bank as per the Govt. Notification (PF) and subject to the EST facilities.
    - (viii) The teachers will perform duties as instructed in Sec.24(1) of the Act and RTE Act and Rules and Karnataka Education


- Act and Rules Rule 17. The teachers should not conduct private tuitions
11. The school should follow the syllabus prescribed by the Education authority.
  12. As intimated in the Karnataka Education Act and rules Sec.19 the school should admit the students in accordance with the facilities available in the school.
  13. Should provide school building and other infrastructure and should not allow any commercial activities or political and non educational activities during day or night.
  14. The school should not run for the benefit of any person or group or association.
  15. The school should be audited from Chartered Accountant a copy of the same shall be submitted to the Deputy Director/Block Education officer at the end of June every year.
  16. The school should follow the language policy as per the Govt. Notification (Kannada language policy-2016)
  17. The management and the teachers should work as per the RTE Act and Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
  18. The school management should follow the Rule and Directions of the Govt. and Department.
  19. It mandatory to update the school information in SATS within in the end of March every year.
  20. If the above mentioned conditions violated, the recognition of the school will be cancelled under the RTE Act 2009 and Karnataka Education Act 1983.
  21. After completion of the school recognition process, the school management shall allow the complete records submitted in online application/information for verification of the public in departmental website.
  22. If the above mentioned conditions violated, the recognition of the school will be cancelled under the RTE Act 2009 and Karnataka Education Act 1983.
