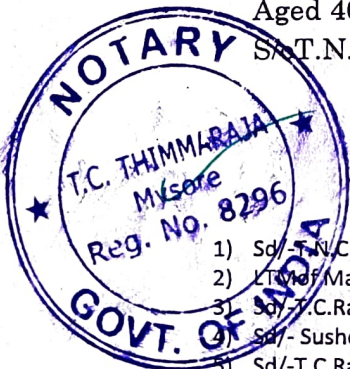
TRUST DEED

We the above trustees have established a Trust in the name of
"Sri Male Mahadeshwara Educational Trust", at Thuruganuru
Village, Bannuru Hobli, T.Narasipura Taluk, Mysore District-
571101 for the purpose of maintenance of the trust, education,
public and religious purpose, construction of education institutions
buildings, maintenance, development, prevention and to help for the
poor, disabled, women and children and other classes by providing
education, shelter etc. Hereinafter, we the above mentioned persons
will act as the trustees of the said Trust.

2. The founder trustees are at liberty to constitute byelaw to
develop the trust and to perform the affairs of the trust. And also
are authorized to amend this trust deed by including any other
objectives without affecting the main objects of the trust for the
development of the trust.

3. **Trust Fund:**

The income gained from the movable and immovable
properties of the trust, gifts received from the donors, benefits

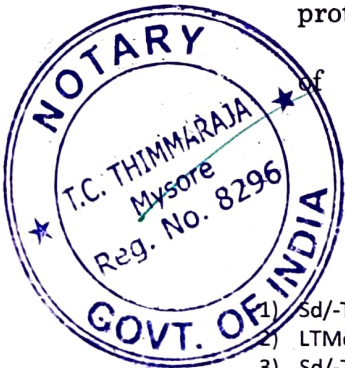

received from the State and Central Government and other persons, loans availed from the bank and other private institutions, donations received from the public and all other financial assistance available from the income gained through the trust activities shall be utilized for the purpose of the trust and shall not distribute the same to the trustees.

4. **Objects of the Trust:**

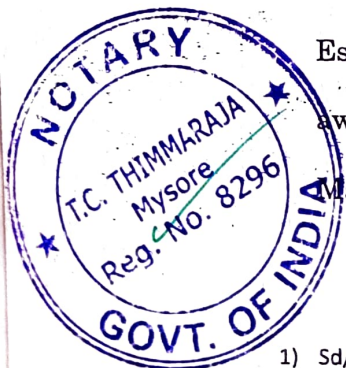
1. Establishment of the Educational Institutions, construction of educational buildings, establishment of art, commerce, science colleges and schools.
2. Establishment of the primary, secondary schools, college, industrial, technical, engineering, medical, law colleges, teachers training centers, job oriented courses etc.
3. On behalf of the trust providing training in poultry farm, husbandry, fishery and agricultural training to the villagers. On behalf of the trust establishment of the Nursery, Primary, Secondary School, College (Arts, Commerce and Science) in English and Kannada medium.
4. To undertake development programs. Taking measures to protect the land, water, language, culture, art, literature etc. of Kannada. Undertaking cultural and sports activities,

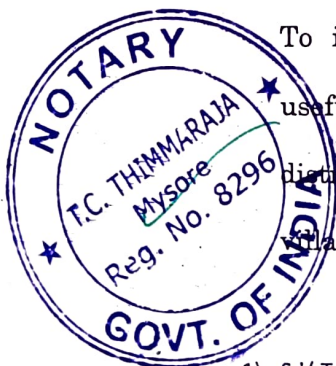
cultural programs like drama, music, dance etc. Engaging in recreational activities.

5. To give opportunities to the youth to act in drama and films and to organize screening of good films. Encouraging the production of short films and organizing competitions to provide opportunities to those interested in subjects like literature and music.
6. To undertake welfare measures for the poor, disabled, orphans, mentally retarded children, widows, disabled, aged people in the society and establish Ashrama for them.
7. To undertake programs that help in the education of poor children, encouraging talented students, establishing computer, typing, sewing, hand embroidery and painting training schools for disabled. Creating awareness on relevant topics by skilled experts.
8. To undertake welfare and development activities of women and children, to cooperate with the Government for prevention and development of the historical areas of the country. Carrying out cleaning programs in slum areas. Establishing medical camps, treatment centers, creating awareness about health, hygiene and disease. Celebrating Martyrs' Day.



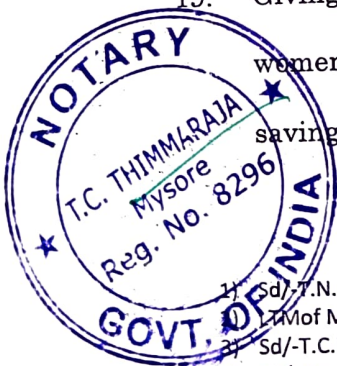

9. To honor the senior artists, writers, musicians etc. and establishment of welfare fund to help the poor artists.
10. To undertake social welfare activities like environmental water forest conservation, wildlife conservation etc. Develop the forest recourses of the state and plant road side saplings and organizing meetings and complexes in urban and rural areas to educate about the environment. In this regard collaborating with the Government, array of government organization etc.
11. Establishing free reading rooms and libraries, organizing free health check-up, eye treatment and blood donation camps, conducting awareness activities about deadly diseases.
12. Celebrating national and state festivals every year. Establishing schools for adults, night schools. Construction of toilets, undertaking of sanitation and rural development activities and providing the food civil facilities to the local residents.
13. Organizing free mass weddings, encouraging widow marriage. To initiate measures for the collection and prevention of usefull books and to establish libraries. Printing and distribution of the books with good contents to children and players and for all categories.



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14. Imparting training in vocational jobs to unemployed youth and women imposing modernity in framing to farmers in rural areas. Training in other disciplines.
15. Establishment of Anganwadi, School, Small, Home and Women Industry Training Centers.
16. Establishment Self-help groups, Strive for all round development of rural people and strive for economic, social education development of rural people. To provide appropriate advice and guidance to women on the Government's Stree Shakti Yojana and the formation of Stree Shakti Groups and other schemes implemented by the Government. Providing food civic facilities to the local citizens, bridging the gap between the government and Stree Shakti Sanghas.
17. To organize inquiry complex on ill effects of drinking and to initiate action steps to elimination of untouchability.
18. Undertaking of the social, cultural, education development programs.
19. Giving suggestions and guidelines to the illiterate and public, women about family welfare, insurance policy and small savings schemes.



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20. Counseling and guidance to the illiterates, general public and women about child labour, superstitions etc.
21. Construction of lakes in rural areas where there is scarcity of water, undertaking rehabilitation and conservation measures. To help the farmers in farming, programs like awareness about farming, soil inspection, implementation of modernity in agriculture, advise and guidance etc. To provide market awareness, information and advice to farmers.
22. To protect the interest of the public and to take all necessary measures.
23. All the measures implemented by the Social Welfare Department on behalf of the trust are to be properly spent and to carry out social welfare programs that benefit the public.
24. To organize sports programs for children, women and children and men and encourage talented athletes.
25. The fund generated in the trust shall be used only for the purposes and development of the trust. That fund cannot be distributed to the trustees for any reason. The members of the Trust shall not directly or indirectly receive any monetary assistance or remuneration.

5. **Constitution, Conduct and Governance of the Trust:**

The founder trustees of the trust shall perform, maintain the activities of the trust as President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, Trustee amongst themselves and if any of the trustees becomes ill, loses mental stability, engages in illegal activities, resigns or brings harm to the interest of the trust, such person shall be removed on the basis of the majority of the trustees and another person i.e. an educated and well behaved person of the town shall be appointed afresh on the basis of the majority of the trustees or any other person deemed suitable. All these resolutions shall be entered in writing by the trustee in a known book and signature of all the trustees shall be taken. The founder trustees may appoint new trustees and having power to remove them. On the instructions of the Chairman and the trustees of the trust and by applying the mind shall perform all the activities of the trust and shall appoint one administrative officer to maintain accounts etc.

6. **Meetings:**

Calling a meeting of all the trustees once in every month, discussing the development of the trust in the meeting and taking new decisions necessary for the development of the trust. Entering such conclusions in the proceedings book. A majority of the trustees shall be final if any decision is to be

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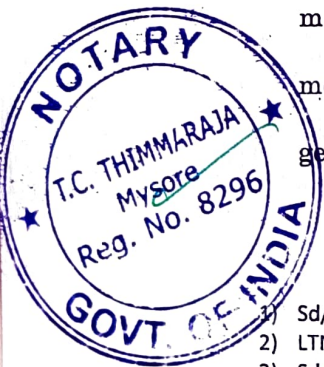
taken. If in the course of taking a decision, assent or descent is indicated equally, the chairman of the meeting shall be entitled to another i.e. majority vote for the right of status held by him.

7. Power of the Founder Trustees:

1. The founder trustees are fully empowered to make suitable arrangements for the development of the movable and immovable assets of the trust. To preserve and develop the movable and immovable properties belonging to the trustees without encumbering them for any reason, and to fulfill the purpose of the trust with the proceeds thereof.

2. Financial Transactions:

An account may be opened in the name of the trust in any nationalized or cooperative bank or in a private financial institution and the Secretary may deposit the funds of the trust in that account and receive funds with the joint signature of the Secretary and the Treasurer whenever funds are required for the programs of the trust. If the secretary and treasurer are not present, they can sign and transact business and before depositing the said money, organize a general meeting and deposit according to the decision of the said meeting and maintain a separate register for each deposit and get the signature of all the trustees.

3. **Appointment of Staff and Sub-Committees:**

The Trust shall have the power to appoint such staff and sub-committees as may be necessary for the development of the trust.

5. **Accounts:**

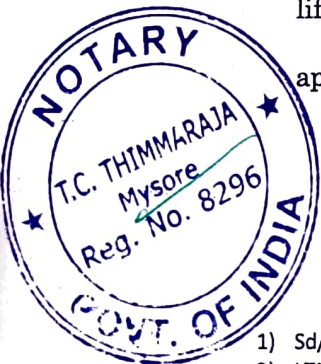
Shall write down all the accounts in respect of the financial transactions of the trust and shall present the same in the trust meeting. It is the responsibility of the trustee to get audit the accounts through the chartered accountant every year. The financial year and the administrative year will be commence from the First of April and ends at Thirty First of March every year.

8. **Powers and duties of the Trustees:**

1) **President:**

1. The President shall convene the Annual General Body Meeting of the Executive Committee and other meetings of the members.

2. The term of office of the Chairma of the trust shall be for lifetime, after whom one or more of the trustee shall be appointed as Chairman by consensus.

2) **Vice-President:**

To Assist the President in his duties and in his absence perform the duets of the day and conduct the meetings of the trustees.

3) **Secretary:**

1) To record the proceedings of the Trustee's meeting in a known book and obtain the signatures of the Trustees. Active participation in development programs of the trust.

2) Writing of the proceedings of the meeting, communicating with the concerned department in respect of the decisions taken in the executive committee meeting, writing of accounts.

3) Take care of all the affairs of court, Govt. officers etc. receiving of subscription, donations, gift from the trustees and donors, institutions and issue receipt. Deposit the amount received by the trust.

4) For the purpose of achievement of the objects of the executive committee, shall have power to receive financial assistants, Gift, donations, loans, aid from members, donors, financial institution, Private or Govt, Non Government organization etc.

4) **Treasurer:**

The treasurer shall take care of all the proceedings of the trust meeting. Record the same in a known register and obtain signature of the trustees and actively participate in the development programs of the trust.

The Secretary and the Treasurer of the trust are authorized to sign the cheques jointly, both of them shall perform bank transactions with their joint signatures.

5) **Trustees:**

Conducting all meetings related to the Trust and shall conduct the meeting of the Executive Committee. Conducting guidance and supervision in affairs related to the Trust. Accepting donation, contribution, donations etc. related to the Trust and delivering it to the President or Secretary.

9. Accept contributions, donations, grants and loans to its fund from the members of the trust or from the Govt. / Public and forward the same to the President or Secretary. Also in order to increase the funds of the trust, the funds may be invested in the Post office, Savings Bank, Nationalized Institutions as permitted by the Income Tax Act 1961 through charity exhibition, advertisement in commemorative issues etc. and



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only the income from such investments can be used for the activities of the trust.

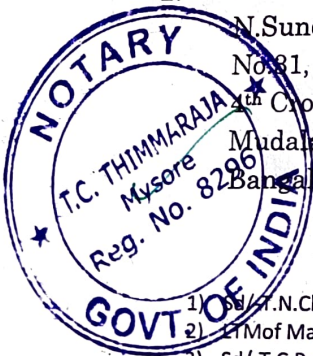
10. The facilities of the trust should be regulated and available to all without any discrimination or religion, caste, creed or gender.
11. The accounts of the trust shall be audited every year ending on 31st March by an authorized auditor under Income Tax Act 1961.
12. Also any amendment contrary to Sec. 2(15), 11, 12, 13 and 80G of the Income Tax Act 1961 shall not be amended without the prior sanction of the Commissioner of Income Tax.

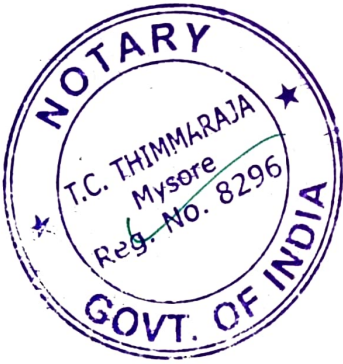

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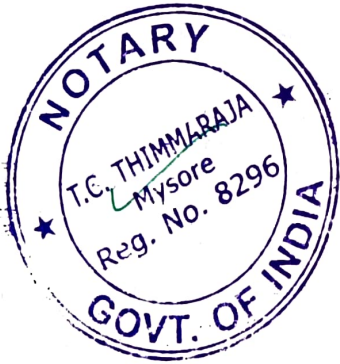
